

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2016) – 103 graduates

College Enrollment

- The class of 2016 was accepted to 101 colleges and universities and will attend 45 different post- secondary institutions.
- 83% of graduates continued their education at a 4 year college or university
- 12% of graduates continued their education at a 2 year community or technical college
- 73% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 27% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2016 were offered \$7,499,528 in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.

College Entrance Exams

SAT

- The top 10% = 2117
- The top 25% = 1916
- Average score = 1546

 - Math = 521

ACT

- The top 10% = 31.8
- The top 25% = 29.3
- Average composite = 22.7
