

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2017) – 81 graduates

College Enrollment

- The class of 2017 was accepted to 89 colleges and universities and will attend 42 different post- secondary institutions.
- 86% of graduates matriculating continued their education at a 4 year college or university
- 14% of graduates matriculating continued their education at a 2 year community or technical college
- 66% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 34% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2017 were offered \$3,510,340 in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.

College Entrance Exams

SAT

- The top 10% = 1445 (out of 1600)
- The top 25% = 1352 (out of 1600)
- The top 50% = 1250 (out of 1600)
- Average score = 1134
 - EBRW= 565
 - Math = 569

ACT

- The top 10% = 32
- The top 25% = 29
- The top 50% = 26
- Average composite = 23

AP RESULTS

- Students took 259 exams in 16 subjects
- AP Scholars- 20
- AP Scholars with Honor- 5
- AP Scholar with Distinction- 4
