Each week will include a water day (weather permitting), special music activities led once a week by a music teacher, and a special weekly theme related in-house field trip by a special visitor! (We do not leave campus at any time.) Summer Enrichment Care is an extension of our PreK3 and PreK4 program. We will be reinforcing skills learned in our three and four year old program at The Early Learning Academy. Centers, calendar, bible, crafts, naptime, and outside play will be a normal part of our daily activities.

Dress Code: Children are to dress in comfortable, weather-appropriate attire and tennis shoes. Shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.

Lunch and Snack: Lunch, 2 snacks, and a drink must be brought from home each day. Milk or water is required for the lunch meal, juice can be sent for snack. There is no refrigeration or heating provided for lunches. Lunches must be balanced lunches. Please be sure to use cool packs and put hot items in a thermos. **No peanut butter or peanut items allowed.** If a child does not bring a lunch, he/she will be charged \$6.00 for an emergency Lunchable which will be provided. If snacks are not brought for the day, you will be charged \$2.00 for the day.

Drop Off and Pick Up: When dropping off your child, please escort him/her to Room 330 which is half way down the hallway located just inside the north portico (playground side of the building.) You will need to "sign---in" your child with the teacher each day. When picking up your child, the same procedure will apply. Please be prepared to show identification when picking up your child in the case our staff member on duty is not familiar with you.

Accidents/injuries: In the event of an accident/injury, an Accident Report will be completed by a staff member. Parent will be notified immediately of any injury other than that of a minor nature.

Potty Accidents: Please have a change of clothing in your child's book bag. In the event of a potty accident, the child will be changed and the wet clothing will be placed in the book bag. If the child wets consistently, they will not be allowed to return for a period of time so they can work on potty training. If a child has a bowel movement accident, the child will need to be picked up immediately and taken home to be cleaned. They will not be allowed to return for the day.

Discipline: In the case of a discipline problem, a Behavior Incident Report will be completed by a staff member. It will then be given to the Parent upon arrival. Parent will sign the report, and it will be given to the Director of the Preschool. ELCA has the right to dismiss any student who habitually exhibits unacceptable behavior without refund of fees.
