Overview of trips for 2017-18

Ministerial trips

Nicaragua \$1750 Feb 15-22

Honduras - \$1900 March 29 – April 7 (will be teaming with a group of students from Landmark)

Jamaica - \$1750 March 29 – April 5 (approximate)

New Orleans - \$500, April 1-5 (will leave midday Sunday or early April 2)

Adventure/Academic trips:

Sea Camp, Florida Keys, March 18-21

Madrid/Barcelona \$3500, March 28 – April 5 (approximate)

New York City - \$1500, April 2-6 (these dates may be shifted from Friday – Tuesday)
