- Some project-based learning

How parents can support Merit at home:

- 1. Stay in communication with the teacher.
- 2. Check grades regularly. Most classes use Alpha Omega to record grades, but upper level math, Spanish, and anatomy use Renweb.
- 3. Have your student attend help class for any general or specific areas of concern.
- 4. Check for upcoming quizzes/tests with them on Renweb.
- 5. Before quizzes, sit down with them and make sure they've saved or printed everything they need.
- 6. When a new unit begins, have them begin preparing for the test at least a week before with the study guide posted on Renweb.
- 7. Review their daily lesson(s) with them every night.
- 8. Help them keep a planner for homework and upcoming due dates.
- 9. Help them clean out and organize their binder weekly.
- 10. Secure audio versions of literature if desired.
