

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2024) – 78 graduates

Post-secondary Plans

- The class of 2024 was accepted to 153 colleges and universities and will attend 45 different post- secondary institutions.
- 92% of graduates continued their education at a 4- year college or university.
- 1% of graduates continued their education at a 2- year community or technical college.
- 7% military, other
- 57% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 35% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2024 were offered \$20.7 million in grants, academic and athletic scholarships. The class of 2024 was offered the most academic scholarship money in the history of the school.
